| _____ | Real Estate - include title, mortgage, insurance (each company will require one) |
| _____ | One each for the federal and state(s) tax returns (a photocopy may be sufficient – ask your tax advisor for specific needs) |
| _____ | Credit Cards (a photocopy is sufficient for notification; however, a certified copy may be needed for insurance coverage/protection for each company) |
| _____ | Stocks, Bonds, & Annuities (each company may require one) |
| _____ | Family Records (you may want one for your records) |
